


Formative Assessment FA:

- Improves student understanding
- Allows teachers to modify instruction
- Enables students to monitor their own progress
- ✓ Assessment FOR learning vs. assessment OF learning
- ✓ Better retention of material

Visual Optics:

- 10 tasks on 10 topics = 10% of final grade Task: write a visual optics problem + worke Submitted online via Moodle
- Grades and feedback given by teacher via Moodle
- Student can resubmit after corrections
- Task is time sensitive
- Students were asked to be creative
- Advantages:
 - very little preparation required
 - individual feedback for students
 - students demonstrated enthusiasm for what can be a "dry" subject

grading was sometimes entertaining! Disadvantages: grading is time consuming




